

UNDERSTANDING AND RESPONDING TO MASS INCARCERATION APRIL 14, 2015 EVENT PARKING

A new parking ramp at Metropolitan State University's St. Paul campus is currently under construction in the location of our former parking lot. For your convenience and as a courtesy to our neighbors, please use the event parking arrangements described below. This information does not apply to university employees or students who have secured permits for designated student and employee parking lots.

Metropolitan State University Parking and Shuttle at Union Depot

Event parking is available in a Union Depot surface parking lot the south side of Kellogg Boulevard, about 4 blocks east (toward campus) of the Union Depot parking garage in downtown Saint Paul, MN. The lot is located at the easternmost edge of this parking complex, just east (on the Metropolitan State side) of the Hwy. 52/Lafayette Bridge overhead, and just west of the Kellogg Blvd/3rd Street bridge leading to Mounds Boulevard and the St. Paul campus. You will see a "Metropolitan State University Parking" sign at the entrance of this lot. If you happen to enter the wrong lot, you can exit without payment within 10 minutes.

You will receive a parking coupon when you enter the lot. You will need this ticket to exit the lot.

Two shuttles will provide pick-up by the shelter at the east end of the lot. **To receive a complimentary parking voucher, be sure to use the shuttle that is dedicated to guests attending the forum on mass incarceration.** Simply ask the shuttle driver. (The other shuttle is dedicated to university employees and students.) Without the voucher, the cost for parking will be \$6, which can be paid by cash or credit at the pay station when you exit.

The shuttle will run continuously from 8 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. and drop you off in front of New Main/Great Hall. Allow at least 15 minutes, although it could be less, for round trips between pick-up and drop-off sites.

Please note:

1. Street Parking is highly discouraged. If you choose this option:
 - a. Be sure to follow all posted parking signs.
 - b. Be aware that by 9 a.m., most on-street parking within 2 blocks of the campus will be occupied and many spots closest to campus are restricted to 2-hour parking.
2. Persons with disabilities: Ten (10) parking spots are dedicated to handicapped parking in the university courtyard lot on Maria Avenue between E. 6th and E. 7th Streets. Handicapped parking IDs are required.
3. On-campus guest parking at various locations are generally limited to 30 - 60 minutes.
